

חָזַק (*chazaq*) verb H2388

-to tie fast, strongly

-to hold fast, be constant, persist

-to make firm, strengthen, confirm

Gen 48:2

And one told Jacob, and said, Behold, thy son Joseph cometh unto thee: and Israel strengthened H2388 himself, and sat upon the bed.

Exo 4:4

And the LORD said unto Moses, Put forth thine hand, and take it by the tail. And he put forth his hand, and caught H2388 it, and it became a rod in his hand:

Exo 4:21

And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden H2388 his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Exo 7:13

And he hardened H2388 Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

-firm

-strong, mighty

Exo 3:19

And I am sure that the king of Egypt will not let you go, no, not by a mighty H2389 hand.

Exo 6:1

Then the LORD said unto Moses, Now shalt thou see what I will do to Pharaoh: for with a strong H2389 hand shall he let them go, and with a strong H2389 hand shall he drive them out of his land.

Exo 10:19

And the LORD turned a mighty strong H2389 west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.

Exo 13:9

And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that the LORD'S law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong H2389 hand hath the LORD brought thee out of Egypt.

-to be heavy

-to be honored

-to be great, plentiful

-to be heavy, dull, insensitive

Exo 5:9

Let there more work be laid H3513 upon the men, that they may labour therein; and let them not regard vain words.

Exo 8:15

But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened H3513 his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Exo 8:32

And Pharaoh hardened H3513 his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Exo 9:7

And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, H3513 and he did not let the people go.

Exo 9:34

And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened H3513 his heart, he and his servants.

Exo 10:1

And the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for I have hardened H3513 his heart, and the heart of his servants, that I might shew these my signs before him:

And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured H3513 upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD. And they did so.

-heavy, abundant, difficult

Exo 4:10

And Moses said unto the LORD, O my Lord, I am not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I am slow H3515 of speech, and of a slow H3515 tongue.

Exo 7:14

And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart is hardened, H3515 he refuseth to let the people go.

Exo 8:24

And the LORD did so; and there came a grievous H3515 swarm of flies into the house of Pharaoh, and into his servants' houses, and into all the land of Egypt: the land was corrupted by reason of the swarm of flies.

Exo 9:3

Behold, the hand of the LORD is upon thy cattle which is in the field, upon the horses, upon the asses, upon the camels, upon the oxen, and upon the sheep: there shall be a very grievous H3515 murrain.

Exo 9:18

Behold, to morrow about this time I will cause it to rain a very grievous H3515 hail, such as hath not been in Egypt since the foundation thereof even until now.

Exo 9:24

So there was hail, and fire mingled with the hail, very grievous, H3515 such as there was none like it in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.

Exo 10:14

And the locusts went up over all the land of Egypt, and rested in all the coasts of Egypt: very grievous H3515 were they; before them there were no such locusts as they, neither after them shall be such.

Exo 12:38

And a mixed multitude went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, even very much H3515 cattle.

Exo 17:12

But Moses' hands were heavy; H3515 and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

To be hard, heavy, difficult, severe, harsh,

Gen 35:16

And they journeyed from Bethel; and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard H7185 labour.

Gen 35:17

And it came to pass, when she was in hard H7185 labour, that the midwife said unto her, Fear not; thou shalt have this son also.

Gen 49:7

Cursed be their anger, for it was fierce; and their wrath, for it was cruel: H7185 I will divide them in Jacob, and scatter them in Israel.

Exo 7:3

And I will harden H7185 Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

Exo 13:15

And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly H7185 let us go, that the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

קָשֶׁה (*qasheh*) adj. H7186

Gen 42:30

The man, who is the lord of the land, spake roughly H7186 to us, and took us for spies of the country.

Exo 1:14

And they made their lives bitter with hard H7186 bondage, in mortar, and in brick, and in all manner of service in the field: all their service, wherein they made them serve, was with rigour.

Exo 6:9

And Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of spirit, and for cruel H7186 bondage.

Exo 18:26

And they judged the people at all seasons: the hard H7186 causes they brought unto Moses, but every small matter they judged themselves.

Exo 32:9

And the LORD said unto Moses, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiffnecked H7186 people:

Exo 33:3

Unto a land flowing with milk and honey: for I will not go up in the midst of thee; for thou art a stiffnecked H7186 people: lest I consume thee in the way.

Exo 33:5

For the LORD had said unto Moses, Say unto the children of Israel, Ye are a stiffnecked H7186 people: I will come up into the midst of thee in a moment, and consume thee: therefore now put off thy ornaments from thee, that I may know what to do unto thee.
